

**ANNOUNCEMENT No. 64/2021
of the Rector of the University of Wrocław
of 29 June 2021**

on the organisation of education in the winter semester of the academic year 2021/2022

Pursuant to Article 23 (1) and (2) of the Act of 20 July 2018 - Law on Higher Education and Science (consolidated text: Journal of Laws of 2021, item 478, as amended), I inform that at the University of Wrocław:

- 1/ education in the winter semester of the academic year 2021/2022 at first and second cycle studies, uniform master's studies, doctoral studies and Doctoral School as well as at postgraduate studies and other forms of education will take place in the form of classroom education with elements of distance learning;
- 2/ the planning of classes in the winter semester of the academic year 2021/2022 should take into account the possibility of changing the course delivery to a hybrid or remote form in the event of a change of the epidemic situation;
- 3/ lectures and classes for students, doctoral students and participants of other forms of education conducted in the winter semester of the academic year 2021/2022 in the University's facilities will be conducted in a residential form (in particular: exercises, seminars, tutorials, workshops, laboratories, lectures, internships and physical education classes);
- 4/ students of postgraduate programmes and participants of courses, trainings and other forms of education may be taught remotely or via a hybrid system. A decision to this effect shall be made by the head of the postgraduate programme, the manager of training courses or other forms of education in consultation with the Dean or the head of a non-faculty unit;
- 5/ it is possible to conduct certain classes for doctoral students (both 3rd cycle studies and Doctoral School) in a remote or hybrid form (especially classes of a general university character). The decision in this respect is made by the Head of Doctoral Studies and the Head of the Doctoral School in consultation with the Dean and the Vice-Rector for Teaching respectively;
- 6/ it is permissible to conduct lectures for students in a remote or hybrid form if the premises of the unit do not allow it to be conducted in a traditional form in compliance with the epidemic and sanitary restrictions in force. The decision in this respect is taken by the Dean or the head of the non-faculty unit;
- 7/ when planning the timetable of full-time classes held in University facilities, it is necessary to take into account the need to limit the movement of students around the University's facilities as much as possible (in particular, assigning groups to specific classrooms throughout the teaching day, creating class blocks) and to coordinate the delivery of full-time as well as hybrid and remote classes;
- 8/ depending on changes in the sanitary and epidemic situation and the guidelines, recommendations and orders of the state law, the conditions for the organisation of teaching in the winter semester of the academic year 2021/2022 may be subject to change.
