

DORMITORY BASIC INFORMATION



UPON ARRIVAL:

- You will need an ID (preferably Passport) to identify yourself for the receptionist.
- If you have booked a room, you will get your key.
- You can get into the dorms 23 hours a day (*each dorm has only one hour closing time during the night*), and 7 days a week. Dormitories are open on holidays.
- If you arrive on weekends you will get a temporary room, which administration office may change on nearest working day.
- Keep in mind that if you will arrive after administration office working hours, you have to be prepared to visit the office on next working day and fill out the form and pay the deposit (read below). If you arrive within office hours, it is best to do it right away.



WE WILL PROVIDE YOU WITH:

- Clean bed sheets (full set)
- Bed
- Stove
- Reading light
- Closets to put your stuff in
- Internet (only one LAN entrance for each room)
Eduroam is available in all of the dorms
- Laundromat (read below)



YOU SHOULD BRING OR BUY:

- Kitchen stuff
- Any sort of personal objects (towel, shampoo, toothpaste, etc.)
- LAN cable and/or a Router
- Cleaning stuff for room – some are provided so check them before trying to buy

VISITS/GUEST POLICY

Please be informed that due to pandemics it is not possible to invite guests or visit other dormitories.

Normally you can enter any other dorm with showing your student or any other ID and mentioning the person or room that you are visiting, however, keep in mind that you will need to leave before 11 p.m. - staying longer than this period may get your host a fee (administration will treat you as a night standing guest). You can have guests for night standing if you made a reservation with administration office before-hand.



OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATIONS

- You can borrow iron table, vacuum cleaner, and other objects from dorm administration (more details at the reception).
- Kredka and Olowek are equipped with garbage chute in the staircases.
- If you find any damaged object (belonging to the dormitory) please visit the reception and file a complaint right away, if not you will need to pay for it upon your leaving.
- To book laundry, you need to go the reception and ask for the laundry book. Choose a date and write down your name and room number.



CITY TRANSPORT

All of the dorms are close to **Pl. Grunwaldzki** station (in front of Pasaż Grunwaldzki) which is the main tram/bus stop in that area. Additionally, there are 2 stops near Kredka and Ołówek.

Trams to use to come to city center:

33 (to Świdnicka/Rynek)
17 (to Hala Targowa)
9 (to Hala Targowa)

To sports center and Koszarowa campus you can use:
