REGISTRATION OF STAY FOR EU CITIZENS



PROCEDURE:

An EU citizen can enter Poland with his/her ID document (a valid travel document e.g. passport or another document certifying identity and citizenship). For stay up to 3 months no legalization of stay will be necessary. For stays exceeding 3 months, and EU citizen will have to obtain a temporary residence permit (*in Polish - Karta pobytu obywatela UE*).

This document will be issued by the Department of Citizens Affairs of the Governor's Office (province administration, *in Polish - Urząd Wojewódzki*).

Citizens of the EEA countries are subject to the same conditions as EU citizens.



WHAT I NEED TO APPLY?:

Temporary residence permits will be granted to Union citizens who have health insurance and sufficient resources to cover their expenses without needing social security support. Documents that have to be submitted by the student to the Governor's Office in order to obtain the residence permit:

- Travel document (passport or other ID document) + copy
- Health insurance document (European Health Insurance Card) + copy
- Official letter of acceptance from University (enrollment certificate)
- Confirmation of tuition fee payment from University
- Application form (in Polish Wniosek o zezwolenie na pobyt)



HOW MUCH WILL THAT COST?

Application is free of charge.
